Listed below are eleven sessions of 10 to 22 pages of this book. These pages need to be read by each person before the session.

The assigned workshop leader can use this same workshop outline for each of the eleven sessions of this study.

- I. Go-round one: "Read aloud your favorite one or two sentences from this reading."
- II. Go round two: "Tell what helped you most in this reading."
- III. Brainstorm on a visible flip chart four discussion topics for this session.
- IV. Lead a discussion on each of these four topics:
 - A. assist everyone to participate
 - B. conduct thoughtful & strong facilitation, especially about time spent on each topic
 - C. participate only with comments that prime more discussion from the group.

For I and II, the go-round processes can be conducted from your seat in the circle. For III and IV, these processes are best conducted standing by the flip chart.

Using the flip chart is important for a strong facilitation of this conversation. Effective facilitation cannot be easily accomplished from a seat in the circle. Practicing workshop leadership that benefits a group is part of this study.
